boil your water until further notice.

We are pleased to report that the problem has been corrected and that it is no longer necessary to
Boil Water, all test have came back as absent for Total Colifirm and E.Coli

We apologize for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience.

EAWA made repairs to a water main leak that affected a large area of our system. The water was off for
several hours. The water samples were collected and the test results came back negative.
